Last year at this time, we brought you good news from CEF around the world. We shared with you that CEF reached more than 15.6 million children in 2013 and that the work of CEF had spread to 187 countries.

The numbers have come in from all over the world and the news for 2014 is even more exciting. There was a 27% increase in the number of children reached. Numbers grew in every region of the world. Five more countries were opened with a newly established CEF work in each country. There are now just 15 countries remaining in the world that do not have the work of CEF in them. CEF has a goal to reach each of these countries by it's 80th anniversary in 2017.

One of the reasons that the work of CEF is growing so rapidly around the world is the great emphasis that is placed on training. As you can see below, 342,441 teachers were trained last year to reach boys and girls.

Here in our local chapter, we held Teacher Training Classes each month during the club year to help our teachers have information and fresh ideas to use as they teach. This past year, 94 teachers participated in our classes.

Last month, more than 70 teenagers participated in Junior Counselor training which will help them at camp. Each person that is trained can then reach others and share what they have learned. We believe that training makes a difference here and around the world.
