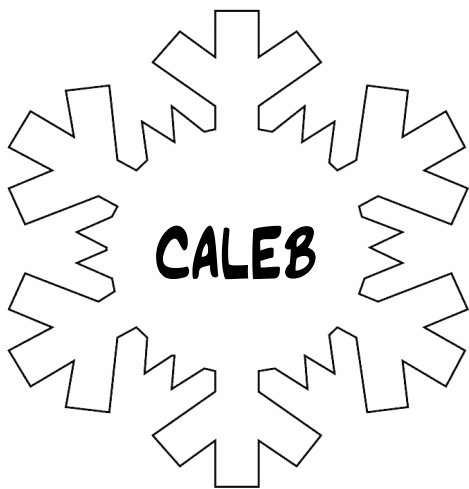
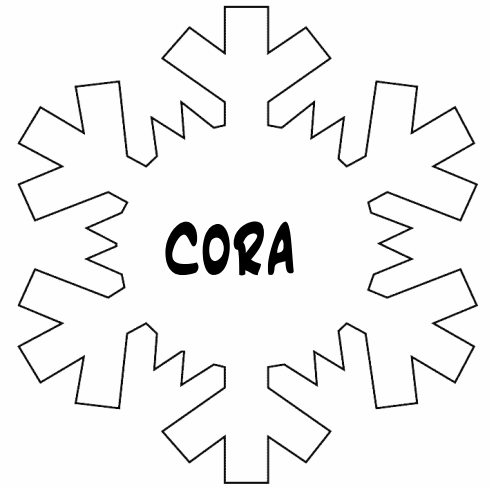


Good News - February 2015



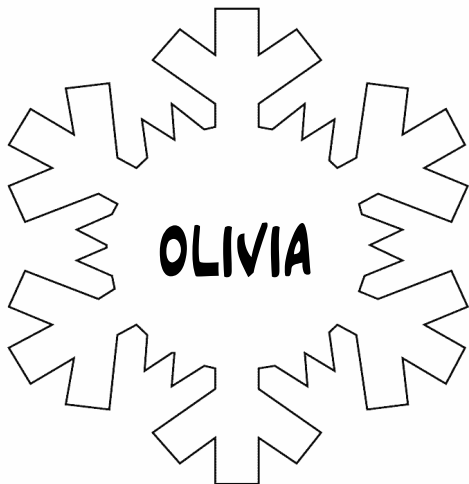
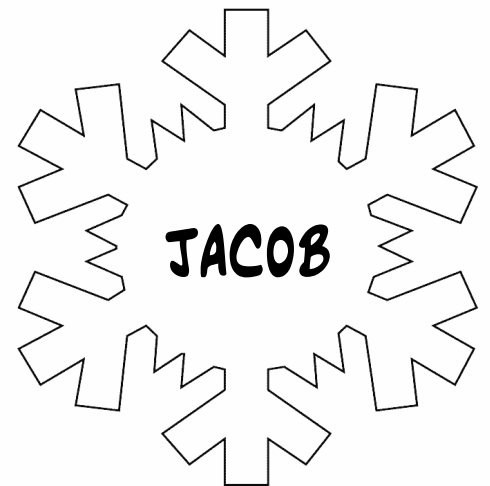
