Spotlight on School Good News Club®

Each week, children all over Franklin and Fulton Counties attend Good News Club where they hear truth from God's Word, memorize verses, sing songs, and play games. The kids have so much fun as they learn. The largest school we work with is Greencastle-Antrim Primary School. There are currently more than 300 students in grades K-2 who come to club each week. They come in shifts and are divided into 14 different clubs.

This year these children are studying the wordless book. They are learning about heaven, sin, the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus, as well as how they can grow in their Christian faith once they have received Christ as Savior. In the Spring semester, they will learn about the life of Jesus.

Keeping a club this large running smoothly is no small feat. The coordinator of this club puts a lot of effort into organizing and managing this club each week. It also takes a team of volunteers and four bus drivers.
