## Spotlight on School Good News Club®

Each year, we start our Fall clubs not knowing which ones will grow and which ones will remain steady or even have a decline in attendance. As schools focus more and more on standardized testing, parents may find themselves more reluctant to have their children attend club. We've seen several clubs get smaller this year for that very reason. But, we've also seen a few clubs reach a record high enrollment this year. In some cases, we've had enough volunteers to divide the clubs and make them more manageable. In other cases, we need more volunteers to help with the increased numbers.

There are several clubs that need a few extra volunteers to allow us to split the club. By law, we must have 2 adults in each classroom, so in many cases, we simply need a helper to be the second adult. Please consider how you might be able to help in one of these clubs. A smaller club means more individualized attention and less discipline problems. It makes a huge difference.
