


Students are being challenged again this year to decorate trees with missionary offering.

Spotlight on School Good News Club®

Each year, we start our Fall clubs not knowing which ones will grow and which ones will remain steady or even have a decline in attendance. God has really been at work in some of the schools and numbers have been growing weekly through October and November.

At one school, the kindergarten teachers sent home permission forms a second time and we saw the attendance nearly double. At another club, attendance has increased so much, they no longer fit on one bus. We're so thankful for parents and teachers who see the importance of sending children to club. We could not do it without their support.

Some of our clubs have grown so large that we need to separate them. Two clubs of 22 children is much more effective and efficient than one club with 44 children. A smaller club means more individualized attention and less discipline problems. It also means we need additional teachers and helpers. Please look at the chart to the right and see if you might be able to give one hour a week to help in these clubs that need you. You could help make these clubs the best they can be for the children and the other volunteers.
