## Around the World

Great things are happening around the world in CEF. The country of Belize recently held an event called "Good News Across Belize" During this event, 32 CEF workers went to four regions of the country and reached more than 10,000 children!

Additionally 258 workers were trained in how to have a Good News Club. Four leaders have stayed behind to help these new recruits as they organize and prepare to teach clubs all across that country.

Later this month, CEF workers from the USA, Canada, and the Caribbean will be gathering in Toronto for a regional conference. Pray for those that are working to acquire visas and funds needed to attend. Pray that it will be a time of refreshment and encouragement.



Much of our club ministry will be over by the end of this month. We're so thankful for nearly 200 volunteers who helped in 98 school clubs, church clubs, and special events that have taken place over the past 7 months. We reached almost 2500 children with the gospel this year.

As we say goodbye to these children, our hope is that they will continue to learn and grow in their faith over the summer. On the very last day of club, the children are challenged in these ways:



Each child is given a Mailbox Club starter lesson. They can use this form to sign up for this fun club and get Bible lessons through the summer.

The children are challenged to call Tel-A-Story, a toll-free number, daily to hear a gospel or Christian growth lesson by phone. Often the teacher will call the number on speaker and let the children listen to a sample lesson to encourage them to call from home.



Second graders are all given Bibles. Many clubbers are also given devotional books. The teachers dedicate at least one week of club teaching the children how to use their Bibles and devotional books on their own.

Children are encouraged to attend a local church. In some cases, pastors of the host church will attend the final club to personally invite the children and their families to that church.



Every child is given a camp registration form and instructions to pass on to their parents. Camp is one of the best ways for us to follow up with the children who attend clubs.

# Camp Update

We're thankful for those of you that have donated money or supplies in the past month. We still need the majority of the donation items that were printed in last month's newsletter. Please let us know if your church or group is able to collect some of these much needed supplies for camp. These donations help us keep the cost low for children to attend.

There are several projects that need to be completed this Spring in preparation for the campers' arrival. We hope to replace all of the windows in the chapel building. The old ones are no longer functional. We also have to remove several dead or precariously-leaning trees before a strong wind does it for us. This past Fall, one of our favorite trees was destroyed by lightning and another by disease. We're hoping to build two forms of shade in those places as they were a very popular place for small groups to meet. We would love to have a gazebo or something similar that could be beautiful as well as functional. We are also hoping to replace our dock that is used to launch out paddle boats. It needs to be made larger due to soil erosion that has taken place over the past few years. If you are interested in donating time or materials to these projects, please let us know.
