Ministry Opportunities

As the year begins, we have some urgent needs that God might use you to fill. Please contact us right away if you want more information about how you can partner with us in one of the following ministries.

1. Good News Club Teacher: We have several clubs that need a teacher. In some cases, large clubs need to be divided into smaller, more manageable groups. Extra teaches make that possible. All materials and training are provided. There are opportunities Tuesday - Friday each week.
2. Good News Club Helper: As clubs grow, we praise God, but we also have a need for additional helpers. We have an urgent need in Roxbury on Thursdays and Scotland on Fridays. Other clubs need help as well. No training or preparation is needed. You must complete background checks.
3. Office Work: Occasionally, we have work that needs to be done in the office. This might include cutting, stapling, counting, laminating, or organizing materials.

Please call or email the office if you can help in any of these ways. An hour or two of your time could make an eternal difference in the life of a child.



CEF International is continuing to ask for prayer for the children of North Korea. They implore us to pray specifically for the doors to open so that Good News Clubs can begin for the children in that oppressive county.
