Good News Clubs® are in full swing and meeting weekly at dozens of locations throughout our two counties. Since the majority of our clubs cover three grades (K-2nd), they use a three year curriculum. Here is what they are learning during those three years of club.

## YEAR 1

The children learn the attributes of God. They go through Genesis including creation, fall, and flood. They learn how to have a quiet time each day and the importance of this habit.

## YEAR 2

*The Wordless Book* is presented first as a way to share the Gospel and then as a way to encourage the children to share the Good News. The children also study Jesus' early life.

## YEAR 3

They continue to study the life of Christ through His death, resurrection, and ascension. They learn how to have the fruits of the Spirit in their lives and they memorize the Lord's Prayer.



## PARTNERING CHURCHES

The majority of our clubs meet at a church that is located near their school. The churches partner with us by providing teachers, helpers, and rooms to meet. These churches are ready to receive the children and their families as part of their ministry of follow-up and often provide invitations to special events or regular services.



## MISSIONS EMPHASIS

Each month, the children in club learn about a missionary that is serving with CEF. They are learning about the Pinedas in Latin America, The Petkofs in Greece, Mrs. Diane in the Middle East, The Acquayes in Africa, and the Hamiltons in the USA. The children love to pray and give to missionaries.



## SHEPHERDING

During the Spring semester, many clubs place an emphasis on shepherding the children. This involves talking to the children one or two at a time, presenting the Gospel, and giving them an opportunity to respond to what they've heard. Pray for our shepherds as they speak to the children.

Plans are underway for another exciting summer of Good News Camp. Start planning now for the week you'd like to volunteer. Here is how you can be used at camp:

1. Teachers: Teach a Bible lesson for 30 minutes each day to a small group of children. All lessons and materials are provided. You'll enjoy getting to know the children and the fellowship you will have with other volunteers.
2. Junior Counselors: (Completed grade 8 and up) - Help a small group by leading them by example and having fun with them during an exciting day.
3. Helpers: (Completed grade 7) - Help around camp in general ways and prepare to be a junior counselor in future years.
4. Bus drivers: We are always looking for drivers to get the kids to and from camp
5. Nurses: Be there for the children to help with cuts, scrapes, and medications. Must have LPN, RN, or EMT certification.

Christian Youth in Action®, or CYIA, is our summer missions program for college students and teens 14 years of age and older. CYIA involves two weeks of training followed by 3-6 weeks of teaching in our local area. We are now in the process of recruiting young people for this coming summer.
