## What is Good News Camp?

A day at Good News Camp is full of stories, fun activities, crafts, and water games. Good News Camp is a program of Child Evangelism Fellowship, CEF; it has been operating for more than 50 years and has more than 1,500 people who participate each summer in locations throughout Franklin and Fulton counties.

## Who can come to camp?

Any child who has completed Kindergarten through (and including) Grade 6 may attend. Campers can come for only one week. Our goal is that any child in elementary school has the chance for a memorable week of camp where they hear about Jesus.

## How much does camp cost?

Good News Camp is affordable. The small fee is a fraction of other camps and less than most daycare. The reason for the low price is that many camp staff are volunteers; they serve because they love children and want them to be able to attend camp.

## How does busing work?

Each week there are several bus stops located in various places – for a schedule please see the back of this paper. In the morning a child can be put on the bus at the pick-up time,

and then in the afternoon the adult should return for the child at the drop-off time. Choose a week that busing is close, or car riders may come any week.

## How do I register my children?

All children must be registered to come – completely fill out one registration form per child. The form on the back of this paper can be copied as needed, or more forms can be printed from the website [www.franklincef.com](http://www.franklincef.com).
