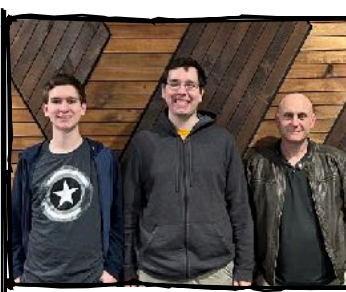
Family News
