

# Spotlight on School Good News Clubs

Each year, we start our Fall clubs not knowing which ones will grow and which ones will remain steady or even have a decline in attendance. God has really been at work, and some of the schools and numbers have been growing weekly through October and November.

A school club that had 6 students last year has nearly 30 this year. Another club grew from two children to nearly 80 in just a few weeks time. We are thankful that God continues to provide the opportunities to teach and the children to come to clubs.

Some of our clubs have grown so large that we need to separate them. Two clubs of 22 children is much more effective and efficient than one club with 44 children. A smaller club means more individualized attention and less discipline problems. It also means we need additional teachers and helpers. Wednesdays are our biggest need right now. If you are available to teach or help for an hour each Wednesday afternoon, please let us know.



This club from Fairview Ave School has more than 40 first graders. We have a second teacher and are praying for one additional helper so we can divide this group into two clubs.
