The kids and I were blessed with an opportunity to travel to North Carolina for our first CEF International Conference. We are thankful for our local committee and the state of Pennsylvania for paying for our entire trip! We arrived at the Ridgecrest Conference Center on Monday morning to join over 1200 other CEF missionaries from over 100 nations! Titus joined the kids track and had a BLAST playing with multiple other children. Noah joined the teen track and LOVED getting to make friends from all around the world. That boy walked around 20,000 steps a day and I've seen an incredible amount of spiritual growth in him since we returned! Maggie meanwhile was glued to my hip, but she did enjoy an opportunity to interview SPAN missionaries for our local chapter.



The kids loved the opening ceremony. Each nation had a representative carry a nations flag across the stage. CEF is currently active in 201 out of 211 nations! Last year CEF reached over 30 million children with the Gospel! That should cause you to stop and say "PRAISE THE LORD." The conference also had testimonials from different leaders around the world. It was encouraging to hear the news from places like the Middle East and Africa! God is doing an incredible work in these areas!

The conference primarily focused on CEF's goal to reach 100 million children each year by 2032. That is quite an ambitious goal, but CEF laid out something called "highways" that will help us reach more children with the Good News of Jesus Christ. This challenged our chapter to set a goal to expand our outreach goal by 5%, meaning we want to reach more children in our two counties, but how are we going to do that? We are still building a plan, but we want to strengthen our CYIA program, start a program called Christmas Party Clubs, and we want to start a youth discipleship based program called Junior Youth Challenge. Pray for us as we start building a strategic plan to effectively reach these lofty goals. We want more and more kids to hear about Christ!





I was able to attend multiple seminars, one was called reaching hurting children. My heart felt a burden because my three precious ones are hurting. It made me wonder how many little ones are hurting that we are unaware of. The trip also made me miss my wife a little bit more than normal. She would have loved the conference.
