It's always a highlight to hear the children shout out the verse of the day!

Miss Emily has been a faithful chapel leader. She has helped the kids focus on their prayer life, how to battle pride, and also how to be faithful, even when things are hard. Emily has adopted the story of my wife, Tiffanie, as an example of being faithful even in the worst situations. Each Friday, Emily tells the kids my family's stories. They all enjoy hearing how Tif and I felll in love in camp, but then their eyes fill up with little tears when they hear that Tif passed away and is home with Jesus. That story has been so powerful for so many campers because they have been carrying such heavy burdens!





Jesus encouraged the little children to come unto Him, and I assure you that Good News Camp is a place where children are invited to come to Jesus each day. Children are provided with countless opportunities to receive Christ as their Savior.
